

Community Chest : Terms and Conditions

1. Groups must register to take part. Registrations are open from Monday June 18, 2018 – Wednesday August 8th, 2018 register online at www.thetele.co.uk/promotions once you have registered your group, you will be sent a welcome pack which includes a poster for your group to display, and a letter for your group to send out and gather more support.
2. Tokens will be printed inside the Evening Telegraph newspaper daily from Monday July 2, 2018 until Saturday July 28, 2018. Each of these publishing dates will include a minimum of 1 token, some days will carry extra bonus tokens. These will always appear on the inside back page of the newspaper.
3. Groups must submit their tokens together with the 'Submission Form' (which is inside the welcome pack sent out to groups after registering) to **Community Chest, Evening Telegraph, 3rd Floor, 2 Albert Square, Dundee, DD1 1DD** to arrive no later than Wednesday 8th August 2018. Alternatively these can be dropped off to DC Thomson Reception opposite McManus Galleries in Dundee city centre.
4. No photocopies of tokens will be accepted.
5. DCT Group and DCT Media employees are not eligible to register a group to take part. However if they are part of a non-profit group that wishes to participate, then another representative from that group may enter on the groups behalf.
6. In the case of Charities, whereby there are no actual members attached to them, we would consider the amount of volunteers as their membership and which category they could enter their group into.
7. Every group to collect a minimum of 50 tokens will win a share of the prize fund. The more tokens collected the higher percentage of the prize fund each group will win. The total prize fund is £10,000, this will be divided equally among the 3 categories so that groups are competing against similar sized groups. Each category has the opportunity to win a share of a third of the total prize fund which is £3,333.33.
 - Category A – Groups with up to 30 members
 - Category B – Groups with 31 to 60 members
 - Category C – 61+ members
8. The Evening Telegraph's Community Chest campaign is only open to non-profit groups in the Evening Telegraph circulation area. Our definition of a non-profit organisation is one where there are no individuals who are benefiting from any profit generated by that organisation at the end of a financial year.
9. In the event that a registered group is found to be a profitable organisation or an official registered business, this will be investigated. After any investigation by the newspaper, if it is evident that a group is for-profit then they would be disqualified from the campaign and all tokens submitted by them would be void.
